Schulenburg ISD's allocation is \$1,407,051 which is to be spent by September 2024. Stakeholder input, including District staff meetings with various departments were held for needs assessments and spending plans over the current and next three school years.

Minimum Required Set-Aside \$187,607

 20% required set-aside for learning loss mitigation, including through afterschool, summer school, extended day/year programs, targeted to students from low-income families, students of color, English learners, children with disabilities, students experiencing homelessness, children in foster care, and migratory students.
